  - (b) The initials of the forename(s) and the surname of the artist indicates in our opinion a work of the period of the artist which may be wholly or in part his work.
  - (c) The surname of the artist indicates in our opinion a work of the school or by one of the followers of the artist or in his style and of uncertain date.
  - (d) Bears signature indicates in our opinion that this is not the signature of the artist.
  - (e) All other terms are self-explanatory.
- 11 OWNERSHIP OF PURCHASES** - The ownership of the lot(s) purchased will not pass to the buyer until the buyer has paid the auctioneers in full the total amount due and the auctioneers have applied such payment to the lot.
- 12 TRANSFER OF RISK** - Each lot shall be at the purchaser's sole risk from the fall of the hammer and shall be sold with all faults and imperfections. 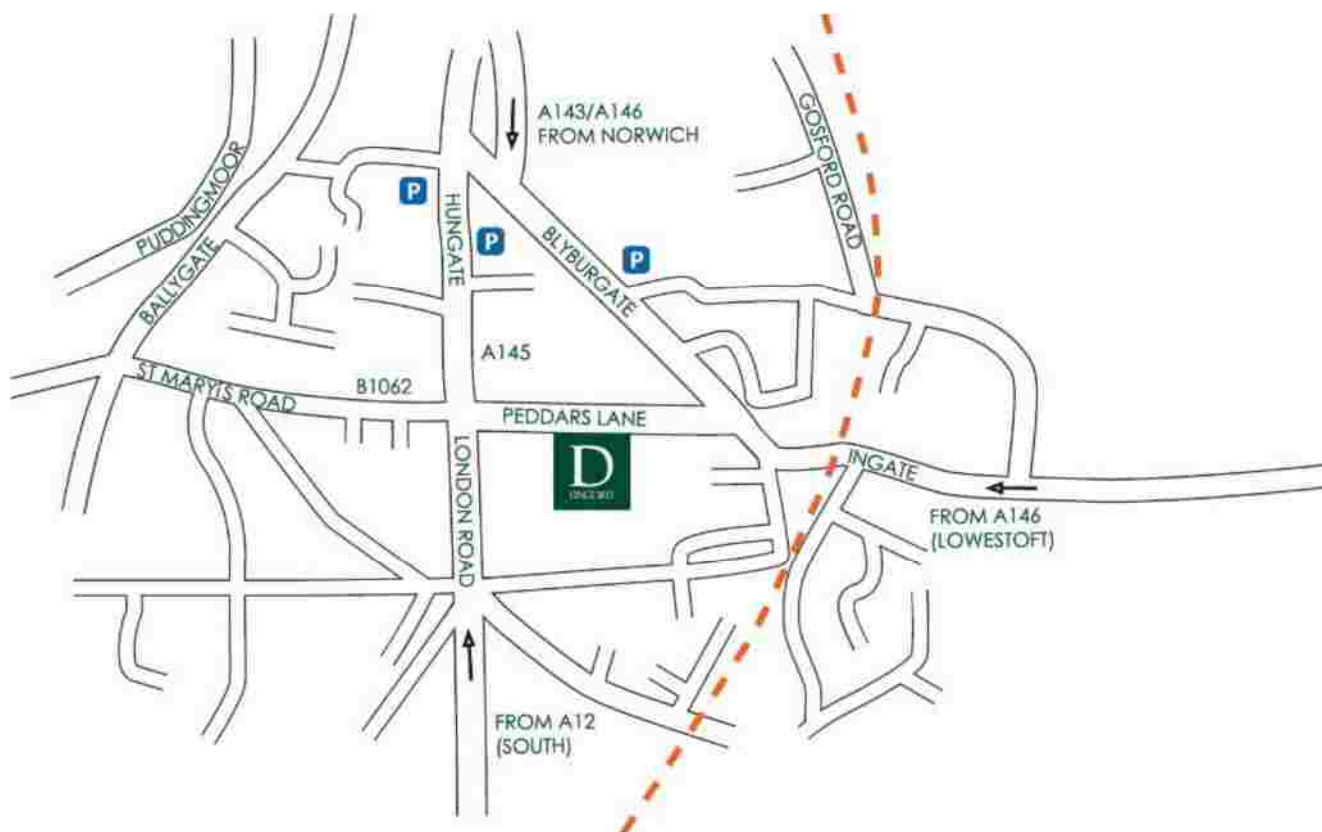
