- 2 REGISTRATION** - To assist the progress of sale, all prospective buyers must register their name and address at reception and collect a bidding number before the sale commences. Should there be any doubts as to price or buyer, please draw the auctioneer's attention to it immediately.
- 3 BUYER'S PREMIUM** - A buyer's premium of 17% plus VAT at the standard rate of the hammer price is payable on each lot.
- 4 VENDOR'S COMMISSION** - Our standard Vendor's commission of 14% plus VAT will be charged up to £1000 - rate negotiable prior to sale. In addition, each lot will be subject to a lotting fee of £3 plus VAT.

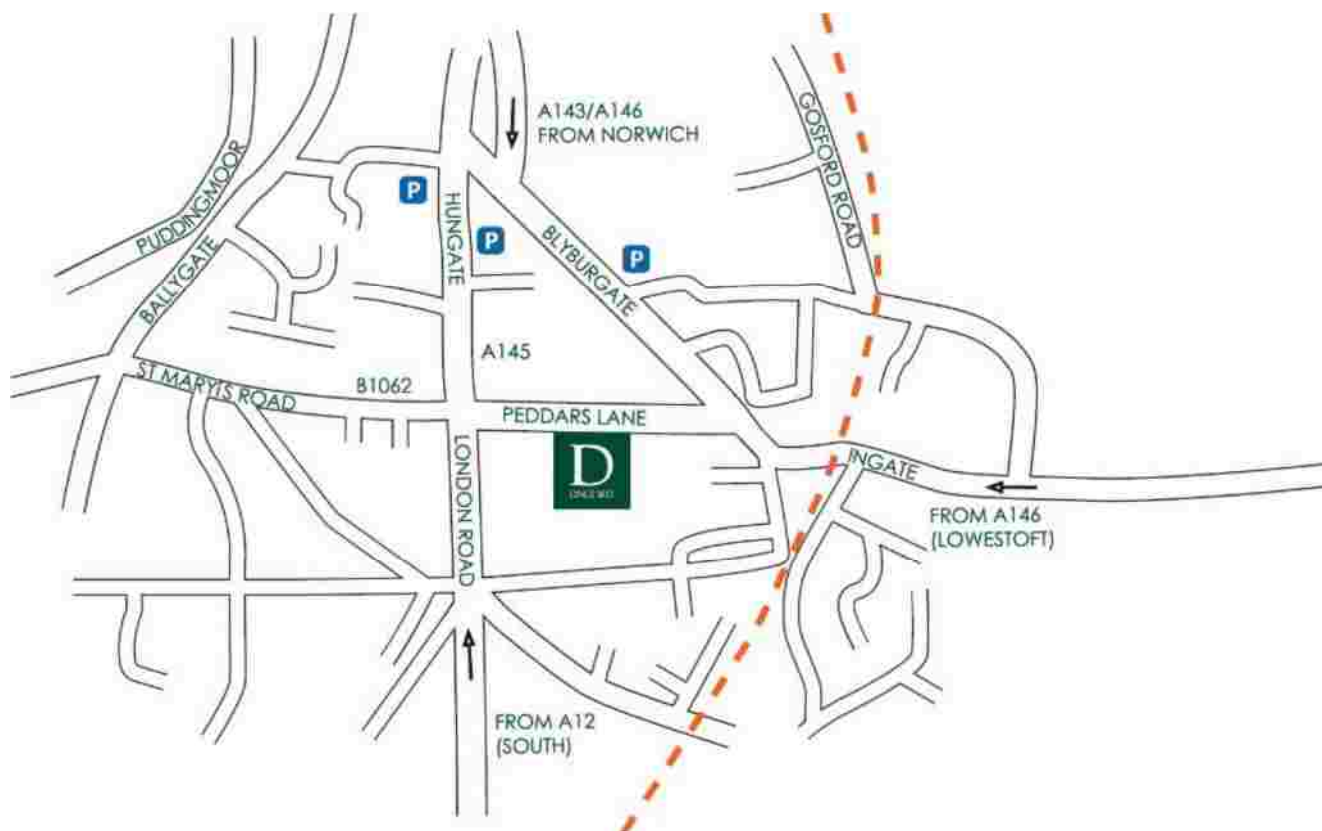
