- 2 REGISTRATION** - To assist the progress of sale, all prospective buyers must register their name and address at reception and collect a bidding number before the sale commences. Should there be any doubts as to price or buyer, please draw the auctioneer's attention to it immediately.
- 3 BUYER'S PREMIUM** - A buyer's premium of 17% plus VAT at the standard rate of the hammer price is payable on each lot.

 - The surname of the artist indicates in our opinion a work of the school or by one of the followers of the artist or in his style and of uncertain date.
 - Bears signature indicates in our opinion that this is not the signature of the artist.
 - All other terms are self-explanatory.
- 11 OWNERSHIP OF PURCHASES** - The ownership of the lot(s) purchased will not pass to the buyer until the buyer has paid the auctioneers in full the total amount due and the auctioneers have applied such payment to the lot.
- 12 TRANSFER OF RISK** - Each lot shall be at the purchaser's sole risk from the fall of the hammer and shall be sold with all faults and imperfections.
