4. VAT will be added to all purchases unless marked with an asterisk (*)
5. Those intending to purchase, who are not known to the Auctioneers, should arrange to either pay in cash or make arrangements with the Auctioneers' Beccles Office at least 7 days prior to the sale.
6. Purchasers are required to remove their goods from the sale meadow by 9th June 2017.
7. **REGISTRATION:** Bidding will be by Buyer's number only. All prospective purchasers must register with the auctioneers at either Rose Farm, Spexhall or Park Farm, Mendham on Tuesday 6th June 2017 or on the morning of the sale providing name, address and providing proof of identity.
8. Viewing: Tuesday 6th June 2017 between 2pm to 5pm or on the morning of the sale.

11. **Directions:**

From centre of Halesworth take the A144 Norwich Road towards Bungay, go past the Huntsman & Hound Public House at Spexhall and Rose Farm will be found on the right hand side.

From Bungay take the A144 towards Halesworth, once in the village of Ilketshall St Lawrence go past the Redisham turn and the farm will be found on the left hand side. (Large vehicles please note it is a sharp turn).

Car/lorry parking is straight through the farm yard on the meadows to the rear of the farm yard.

From the A144 turn into Grubs Lane and continue bearing left onto Gavell Street. At the staggered cross roads turn left then right onto The Street. At the T junction in Rumburgh turn right passing the Rumburgh Buck towards St Margarets. After travelling through St Margarets you will come to St Cross, take the left turn and follow the road through to Mendham, Foxes Lane is the second turning on the left and the sale will be found at the top of the hill.

Note The Mendham Sale will start at 3pm or 90 minutes after the completion of the Rose Farm Sale whichever is the later.

CONDITIONS OF SALE

FIRST The highest approved bidder shall be the purchaser. No bidding to be retracted. Each purchaser shall give up his (or her) name and address when asked for. Should any dispute arise between two or more bidders, the lot in dispute shall be put up again and resold; and the Auctioneers reserve to themselves the right of refusing any person's bid, and shall be the sole Arbitrators on any matter is dispute during the sale. The vendor also reserves the right to bid by his agent.

SECOND The full purchase money for each lot shall be paid for at the fall of the hammer (if required) or directly after the close of sale. Each and every lot shall immediately on the fall of the hammer be considered as delivered, and shall remain in every respect at the absolute risk of the respective purchaser or purchasers thereof, and shall be removed from the place of sale at the purchaser's expense, and taken with all faults and errors of description, the Auctioneers not being answerable for the authenticity, genuineness, or completeness of any lot. 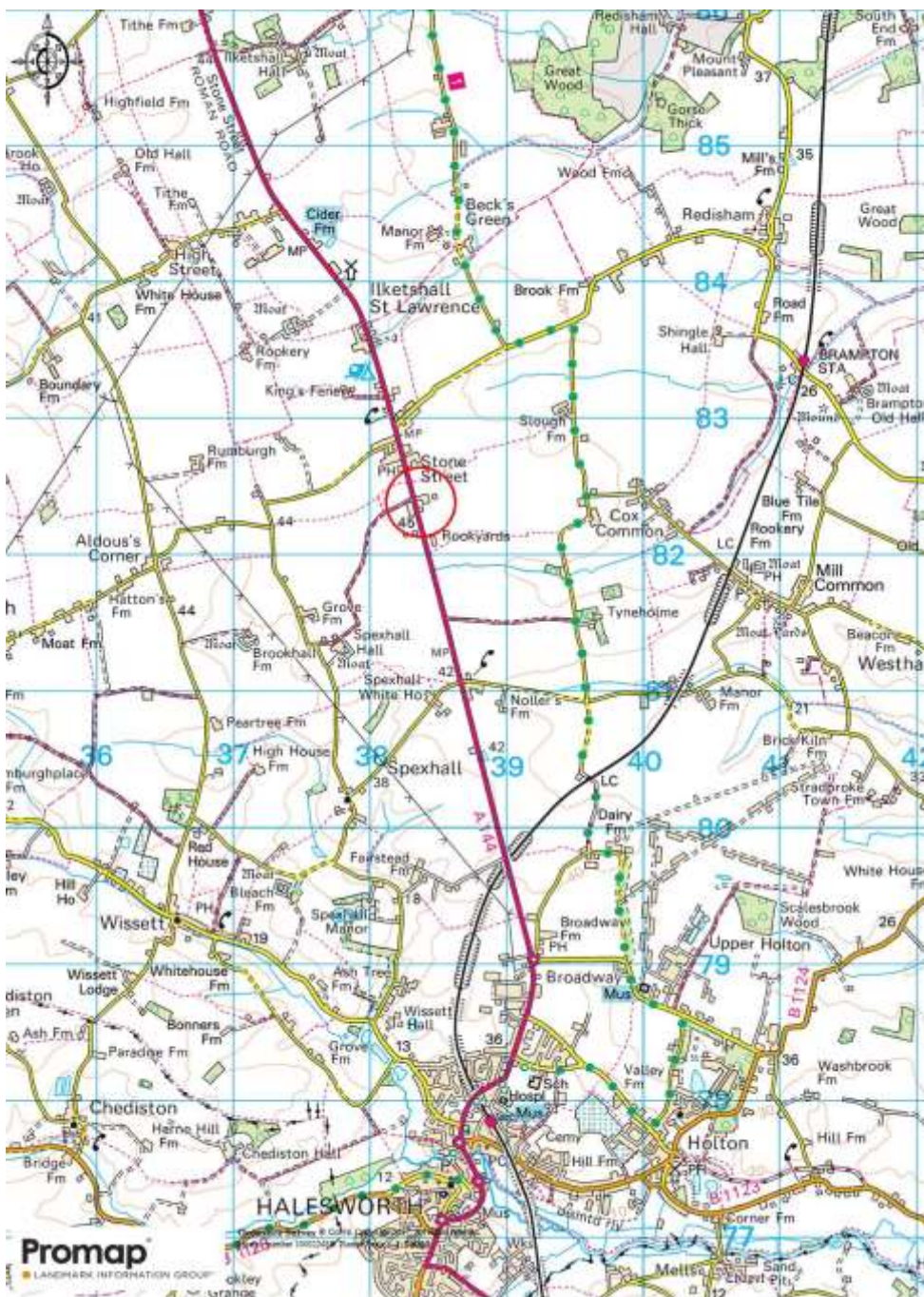
